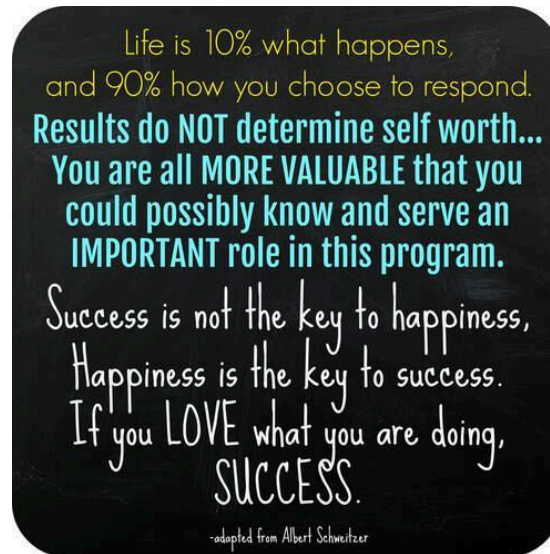


## AUDITION RESULTS will be posted soon!



### Things to remember:

1. These are difficult decisions and we are PROUD of all of you. You are perfect as you are. Trust us to set you and each ensemble up for success.
2. Our program does not have a “star ensemble,” the program is the star. Every choir offers opportunities for great singers and performers to learn, grow, and thrive.
3. As with all auditions, there will be a variety of outcomes and emotions—we would encourage students to focus on **growth and opportunity** as much as possible when processing results and support one another in both the excitements and the disappointments that will be inevitable.
4. If you have questions about audition results, directors will gladly schedule a time to have conversations about opportunities for **growth**. We will not talk about other student’s scores or auditions. *As students completed these auditions, students should be having these conversations, if desired after processing results, with directors beginning Tuesday, June 2. (We will not respond to emails regarding auditions prior to this date.)*

### Nuts & Bolts:

1. New Parent/Student Square groups will be created. Cut Time will be the primary form of communication for the summer.
  2. Check your email/messages regularly throughout the summer.
3. If you auditioned for show choir, your name should appear on one of the four show choir rosters. The only exception is if your ensemble preferences (indicated on your audition form or in your video submissions) conflict with the results of auditions.
4. Students who auditioned for core/curricular choirs whose names do not appear in Concert Choir, Cantorei, or Chorale will be automatically enrolled in Ankeny Singers for the fall.
